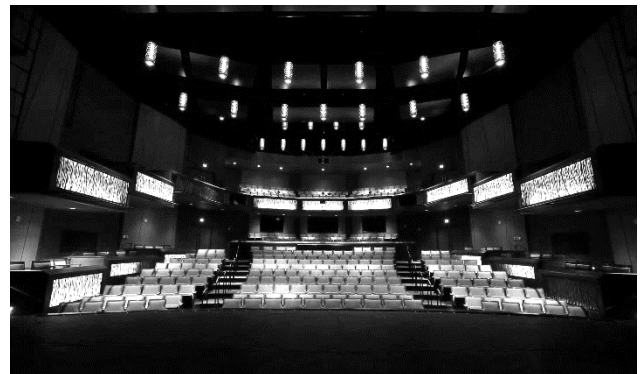
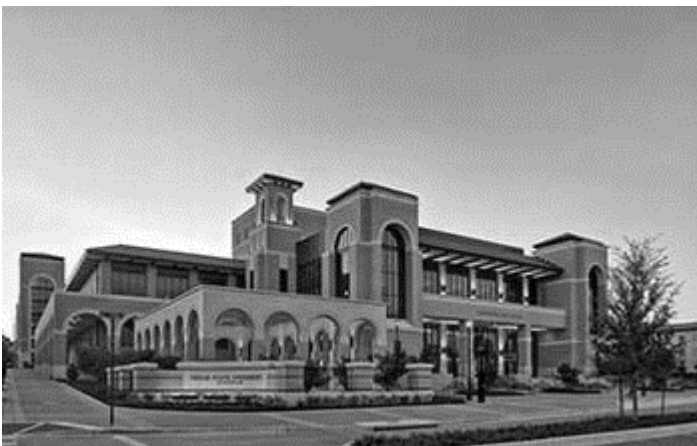

COSTUME PICK-UP/STUDIO PHOTO WEEK

4/15-4/18: Costume Pick-up

- Please arrive 15 minutes prior to end of class.
- Detailed information about your costume, accessories, props, hair and makeup will go out with costumes.
- Students will be required to purchase the designated color and brand of tights for their costume (see 'TIGHTS' section on pages 11-12).
- Costumes will not be released unless signed out by a parent.
- JOURNEY SCHOOL: You will pick up/sign out your child's costume during photo week at WDE.

4/29-5/2: Studio Photo Week

- Jetter Photography will be photographing classes at WDE this week.
- Photos will take place during regular class time.
- Please return photo order form (attached) prior to photo week.
- Makes checks payable to: Jetter Photography.
- On photo week students need to arrive at their regular class time in full costume, hair and makeup.
- All classes will take group shots. Optional individual or sibling shots are also available.
- JOURNEY SCHOOL: Your photos will take place Tuesday, 4/30 at 5:00 p.m.

REQUIRED TIGHTS BY CLASS

Students will be required to purchase the designated color of Theatricals brand tights for their costume. Tights are available for purchase at WDE or you may purchase them on your own. Some costumes require special undergarments and are listed below.

EDC Senior Prep “Fosse”- Black stirrup tights

EDC Senior Prep “Blank Stares”- Nude stirrup tights, see Ms. April for specified bra for this costume

HAIR AND MAKEUP

All dancers must have approved hair and makeup. We want to see these beautiful faces under the heavy stage lights.

- Be sure to pack a hand mirror for your dancer to do touch-ups during the show.
- Be prepared with lots of bobby pins, hair ties that match the color of your dancer's hair, and hair spray/gel. Make sure your dancer has no baby hairs/fly-aways.
- Hair bow and hair clip placement will be included on each dancer's costume check-list.
- No jewelry, hair ties on wrists or nail polish.
- Please do NOT use a bun-maker (donut bun).
- *Short Hair:* If your dancer's hair is too short for a pony tail or a ballet bun (see below) they will need to part the hair on the front left side. Pull the front bang to the right side and bobby pin in front of and above the right ear. If you have any questions, please see Ms. April.

Boys:

- **Hair:** combed, with hairspray.
- **Makeup:** Foundation, powder, a little blush and chapstick.

Pre-K and Journey School:

- **Hair Style:** High Ponytail. Draw a line from the back of the ear to the top/crown of your dancer's head. This is where the base of the ponytail will need to be.
- **Makeup:** All Pre-K dancers MUST wear foundation, powder, heavy pink blush, heavy black mascara (3 coats) and pink lipstick.

All WDE classes (other than Pre-K, Journey and EDC):

- **Hair Style (non-ballet dances):** High Ponytail. Draw a line from the back of the ear to the top/crown of your dancer's head. This is where the base of the ponytail will need to be. No baby hairs/fly-aways. Be prepared with lots of bobby pins, hair ties that match the color of your dancer's hair, and hair spray/gel.
- **Hair Style for Ballet dances:** Classic Bun. Twist ponytail (see instructions above) into a classic bun for the ballet dance. No baby hairs/fly-aways. Be prepared with lots of bobby pins, hair ties that match the color of your dancer's hair, and hair spray/gel. A hairnet is required for making a bun quickly and neatly.
- **Makeup:** All dancers MUST wear foundation, powder, heavy pink blush, neutral cream color or brown eyeshadow, dark brown or black eyeliner, heavy black mascara (3 coats) & red lipstick with matching liner.

EDC:

Full competition makeup with earrings. Follow WDE hair instructions.

DRESS REHEARSAL

Friday, May 10, 2019

4:15-9:45 p.m. (see below for your dancer's exact times)

- ***Dress Rehearsal is mandatory. If your dancer misses dress rehearsal they will run the risk of not being allowed to perform at the recital.***
- ***All live action photography will be done at Dress Rehearsal. If you are late, miss your call time or miss your dance, you will not be in the live action photos.***

4:15 CALL TIME- Dress in first costume with full hair and makeup.

4:15 CALL TIME- Dress in first costume with full hair and makeup.

5:15-5:45 REHEARSE CURTAIN CALL AND BOW

5:45-7:30 RUN-THROUGH

7:30 DISMISSAL FOR THIS GROUP

5:00 Show Participants:

7:00 CALL TIME- Dress in first costume with full hair and makeup.

7:30-8:00 REHEARSE CURTAIN CALL AND BOW

2:00 SHOW

- Pre-K call time- 1:00 p.m.
- All others- 12:30 p.m.

5:00 SHOW

- Pre-K call time- 4:00 p.m.
- All others- 3:30 p.m.

Before the Show:

- Arrive Early! Dressing room head count will begin right at call time.
- Arrive in full hair and makeup (see HAIR AND MAKEUP section above on page 13), dressed in your first costume, wearing a cover-up that doesn't go over the head. Do not wear dance shoes outside.
- NO UNDERWEAR UNDER YOUR COSTUME. No panties or sports bras unless specifically requested. If your dancer needs a little extra support, a nude leotard or nude dance bra with clear straps may be ordered from DiscountDance.com, Target or Amazon.
- Dressing rooms will be marked with dancer's name. Check in with your dressing room monitor when you arrive.
- Bring a spill-proof water bottle to have backstage. Only dry snacks are allowed. Do not bring any food or drinks that could stain or spill on a costume.
- Pack your dancer's makeup bag with extras. Bobby pins, safety pins, hairspray and gel.
- Make sure your dancer's name is on ALL shoes, makeup bags, costumes, and dance bags! WDE is not responsible for items left or lost.
- No cell phones allowed in the dressing room. If a student is found with a phone, it will be held by a staff member until released to a parent AFTER the recital.
- DO NOT TAKE ANY PHOTOS IN DRESSING ROOMS.

During the Show:

- No photography or video allowed during the performance or dress rehearsal for your dancer's safety. You may take photos before and after the show.
- Each dancer will receive a professional digital video recording and professional live action photos of the recital.
- All dancers (excluding Pre-K) will be backstage for the ENTIRE SHOW.
- **Pre-K Dancers:**
 - Pre-K Dancers will sit in their parent or guardian's lap during the show. Any dancer sitting in a chair must have a ticket for that seat. You may use your dancer's free ticket or purchase an additional ticket if needed.
 - Dancers must be wearing a cover-up over their costume while in the audience.
 - Parents will need to walk their dancers backstage, fully dressed in their costume, 5 dances before they perform and check in with their dressing room monitor.
 - After their dance, parents can pick up their dancer back stage and bring them back to the audience until it's time to report for the final bow. They will need to stay in costume for the final bow.
 - Bring your Pre-K dancer backstage 3 dances before the last number for the final bow.

After the Show:

- Dancers will be released to a parent or guardian only from the dressing room after the show. Dancers MUST BE SIGNED IN AND OUT by a parent or guardian only.

We plan on having a beautiful recital for the Wimberley Dance Elite Dancers and their families. We know that for many of our dancers, this will be their first time participating in a dance recital.
